



# Getting to the Danish EPA (MST) - from Kastrup Airport

The easiest way of getting from Kastrup Airport to the EPA is by using the Metro system.

The Metro station is located at the end of Terminal 3 and is covered by the roof of the terminal. The Metro operates at 4-6 minutes' intervals during the day and evening hours and at 15-20 minutes' intervals during the night. The travel time from the airport to Christianshavn Metrostation where the EPA is located is approximately 10 minutes.

Tickets for the Metro are available at the DSB ticket sales counter in Terminal 3. Alternatively use the ticket machines located at the platform, but please note that the ticket machines do not accept notes, only coins and credit cards such as MasterCard and VISA.

After arriving at the Christianshavn Metro station, please follow the map below. Direction NW along Torvegade, and then take a right at Strandgade. Proceed along the street 200m and find the main entrance to the Danish EPA on the left hand side of the road, immediately before the bridge. A green banner carrying the text "Miljøstyrelsen" indicates the location of the building.
